## Wanamaker Award

The Robert "Wanamaker Award" was established by the California Association of Airport Executives (CAAE), the forerunner organization to SWAAAE, to honor the memory of Robert Wanamaker, a long-time member of the association and Executive Emeritus. Robert Wanamaker was the owner of the airport in El Monte, Los Angeles County from 1954 through 1971. He joined the CAAE in 1958 and served on numerous committees and as President in 1964. As an attorney, Robert Wanamaker gave generously of his time to the solving of legal matters for the CAAE.

The Wanamaker Award recognizes individuals who are not currently exercising active responsibility for the management, general supervision, or administration of a public-use airport who have devoted their skills, talent, personal resources, time, or alliances in the betterment of airports or aviation in its entirety.

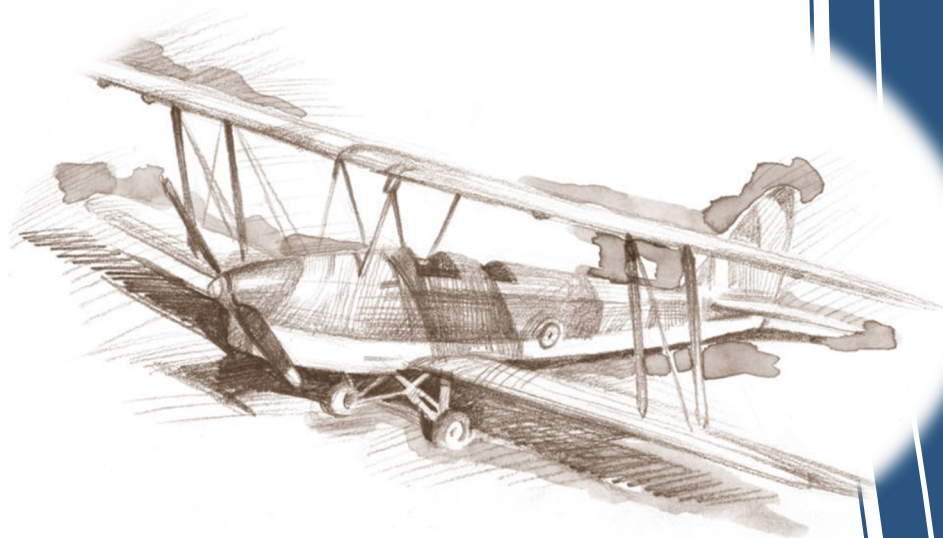
## Young Professional Award
